# Fearing Frauds, Auditors Hire Investigators

Suspect more corporate governance issues as physical verification has become difficult amid lockdowns

**Mumbai:** Auditors are roping in forensic investigators to check authenticity of key documents, trail emails and also scrutinise certain inter-group overseas transactions as they suspect fraud, round tripping and other corporate governance issues spiked during the Covid-19 crisis. During the Covid pandemic and on and off lockdowns, auditors are finding it increasingly difficult to verify bank statements, third-party sales orders and other documents on which sales, profits and general health of a company is determined. With several regulators already coming down hard on audit firms, the fear is also that if they do not raise enough red flags, they could be stranded with a fraud situation. Industry trackers say in the last few months, investigators are being roped in more and more for audits. "There have been instances when an auditor feels something is amiss, either in documents or transactions, forensic and even cyber security teams are being roped in," said Vinayak Padwal, senior partner with an audit firm. "In most cases, these are in-house teams that a firm has, but if there's a suspicion of money laundering or other regulatory issues, then an in-depth probe is also being done in certain cases." Forensic investigators have even stumbled upon several frauds involving some employees and, in some cases, senior executives and promoters. "Verifying authenticity of the documents is a huge concern for auditors and, in many cases, forensic experts are being roped in when a question related to the veracity arises," said Gaganpreet Puri, leader —

risk and regulatory A&M India. "But auditors have to consider a fine line around the nature, extent and timing of these procedures as their remit is audit and not investigation. These extended procedures have to be in line with audit responsibilities and not go beyond their remit." In a recent incident, an audit partner in a large firm found something suspicious while auditing a certain automobile component company. The auditor somehow found something fishy in the way sale had happened — large sales orders placed in a span of 30 minutes by five different companies — few days before the quarter ended. A cyber security team was roped in and it was found that all the five orders came from the same IP address. The audit partner suspects this was a desperate attempt to placate lenders for the time being. In another incident, an Indian audit firm found that an infrastructure company had recently entered into some agreements with an unknown company. The contract was done through a UAE-based subsidiary. The Indian auditor doesn't have access to the UAE subsidiary's accounts as it was audited by a separate auditor, but the consolidated accounts need to have a clear picture. The auditor roped in his forensic team and it was found that this could be a case of round-tripping or siphoning of funds. The investigators traced back the ultimate ownership of the unknown company to a holding trust in the UK and it was concluded that it could be a front for one of the promoters.

# Assam urges its residents to avoid travel to Mizoram

**GUWAHATI:** Assam issued an advisory on Thursday on travelling to Mizoram as tensions between the northeastern neighbours continued to simmer three days after a fierce gunbattle at a disputed border killed seven people and injured 41 others.

Assam asked its residents not to travel to Mizoram due to safety concerns and asked those already in the state to exercise caution. The unprecedented advisory came on a day a state minister upped the pitch against Mizoram, which alleged that the larger state had imposed an informal economic blockade by refusing to let goods pass through.

"Given the critical prevailing situation, the people of Assam are advised not to travel to Mizoram as any threat to personal safety of people of Assam cannot be accepted," said the advisory issued by MS Manivannan, commissioner and secretary in the home and political department.

The advisory, which was brought into force with immediate effect, urged the people of Assam staying in Mizoram "due to work-related compulsion" to exercise "utmost caution".

"Certain Mizo civil society, students and youth organizations are constantly issuing pro-

vocative statements against the state of Assam and its people," the advisory read. "In view of the above and with the purpose of ensuring safety and security, a travel advisory is hereby issued to all people of Assam," it added. The police forces of the two states fought a pitched gun battle at a disputed border in southern Assam on July 26, in which six Assam policemen died. Assam claimed Mizoram police opened fire on its forces who objected to a road being constructed by Mizoram on a patch of forested land it claims. Mizoram claimed the land belongs to it. Both states maintain that it was police personnel from the other side which started the shootings.

The clashes led some residents on the Assam side to block

some sections of NH 306, disrupting transportation to the neighbouring state.

On Wednesday at a meeting called by Union home secretary Ajay Kumar Bhalla, the two sides agreed to withdraw their police forces in the four-km disputed stretch which runs between Vairengte in Mizoram and Lailapur in Assam along NH-306. They also agreed to the deployment of central paramilitary troops in the area till a permanent solution is found. But tensions refused to die down. "We have always wanted to solve the matter by dialogues. But we cannot talk about peace over six dead bodies of our officials," said Assam urban development minister Ashok Singhal who visited Lailapur border area.

# Centre rushes team to Kerala amid rise in Covid infections

**NEW DELHI:** The Union health ministry sent a six-member multi-disciplinary team to Kerala on Thursday to monitor the on-ground Covid-19 situation there and suggest measures to control the spread of infection, as the state remains the country's biggest hotspot region accounting for nearly half of India's new cases.

The central team, headed by director of National Centre for Disease Control (NCDC) Dr Sajeet Singh, will reach Kerala on Friday, according to a statement by the health ministry.

Nearly one in every two new Covid-19 infections recorded in India over the past week have come from Kerala, that is defying the national trend of falling infections since the decline of the country's brutal second wave of infections. As of Wednesday night, the state has 150,040 active cases, accounting for 37% of all such cases of the country.

According to data from the health ministry, seven districts in Kerala have seen reporting an increase in new infections over the previous month.

The average weekly positivity rate - proportion of samples that return positive among total tested, generally indicative of the

spread of the infection within the community - currently stands at 12.1% in Kerala, nearly five times that of the national average of 2.4% in the same period. The World Health Organization recommends that a 5% threshold for positivity rate be taken at which the Covid-19 infections in an area can be said to be testing adequately according to the caseload at hand. A number higher than 5% signifies that the region needs to test more to identify cases and isolate them as soon as possible.

"Central government is sending six-member team to Kerala headed by NCDC director. As [a] large number of Covid cases are still being reported in Kerala, the team will aid state's ongoing efforts in #COVID19 management," Union health minister Mansukh Mandavivya on Thursday.

To be sure, there are indications that the state has been able to detect true infections better than any other region.

Data released by the health ministry on Wednesday from the fourth round of national serosurveillance by the Indian Council of Medical Research showed that the prevalence of antibodies - a measure for whether someone has been exposed to Sars-CoV-2 virus - was 44.4% in Kerala, the lowest among the states surveyed.

# EXPERT PANEL CALLS FOR NOD TO STUDY ON MIXING DOSES OF COVAXIN AND COVISHIELD

**NEW DELHI:** An expert panel of India's central drug authority on Thursday recommended granting permission to the Christian Medical College (CMC) in Vellore for conducting a clinical trial of mixing of two Covid-19 vaccines - Covaxin and Covishield - people aware of the matter said.

The panel also recommended giving approval to Bharat Biotech for carrying out a study on interchangeability of its Covaxin and the under-trial adenoviral intranasal vaccine candidate BBV154, but asked the Hyderabad-based firm to remove the word "interchangeability" from the study title and submit a revised protocol for approval. "The SEC (subject expert committee) after detailed deliberations recommended granting permission to CMC, Vellore for conducting the phase-4 clinical trial covering 300 healthy volunteers for mixing of Covid-19 vaccines Covaxin and Covishield," a person familiar with the matter said.

"The aim of the study is to assess whether a person can be given two different vaccine shots - one each of Covishield and Covaxin - to complete the inoculation course," the source said.

The group also discussed the application by Biological E for conducting Phase 2/3 clinical trial of its vaccine in the population aged 5 to 17 years, along with the safety and immunogenicity data (after dose 1) from the ongoing phase 2/3 clinical trial on adults.

# HC stays directive on mandatory vaccination

**KOHIMA:** The Kohima bench of the Gauhati high court stayed Nagaland's order asking government employees to get fully vaccinated or produce Covid-19 negative reports every 15 days, adding to a growing debate on the legality of compulsory vaccination and its potential impact on fundamental rights.

The decision, which was made public on Thursday, came on a public interest litigation (PIL) challenging the government's July 17 order issued by the chief secretary. The verdict comes days after a similar judgment by the Manipur high court.

In the order, Nagaland told the staff of the civil secretariat and directorates to get vaccinated or produce Covid-19 negative test reports every 15 days to attend office, failing which the government would stop paying their salaries beyond July 31 and they will be sent on unpaid forced leave.

During Wednesday's hearing, the government advocates objected on maintainability of the PIL and submitted that no interim order be passed. However, the court ordered a stay on the government order and directed to list the matter on August 18 along with similar other PILs on the same issue.

"Till the returnable date, fees should not be charged for testing

from government employees and their salaries should not be stopped for reason of not having being vaccinated," the court stated. The court also kept the question on maintainability of the PIL open "for the sake of clarity".

This is the most recent in a raft of similar orders and observations by high courts.

In Meghalaya, the government had made it mandatory for shopkeepers, vendors, local taxi drivers and others to get themselves vaccinated before resuming businesses. On June 23, the high court ruled against any policy that makes vaccination mandatory to exercise other fundamental rights. The court said mandatory vaccination affects an individual's liberty significantly more than affecting the general public, and impinges upon the autonomous decision of an individual human being of choosing not to be vaccinated.

On July 13, the Manipur high court ruled that "denying people their livelihood... would be illegal on the part of the state".

# Jet staff ask govt to help solve issues

Non-payment of salary dues and job uncertainty top the list of concerns

An employees' group of Jet Airways India Ltd has sought the intervention of newly appointed civil aviation minister Jyoti Radhika Scindia for resolving issues of employment under the new owners of the airline and clearance of social security dues that have accumulated under the previous management of the airline.

The All India Jet Airways' Officers and Staff Association, which is affiliated to National Front of India Trade Union, said in a letter addressed to Scindia on 27 July that it was shocked to see the paltry salary dues offered by the new owners of the airline, about 152 crore, which is a minuscule amount compared with the original claims of employees.

"A large number of employees continue to be on the payroll of the company Jet Airways who have indicated complete uncertainty in respect of their continued employment as they believe that they would contribute to the success of the revived entity of the successful resolution applicant," the letter said.

A copy of the letter has been reviewed by Mint.

"If the airline has to take off into the skies under a revived management, it is imperative that employee issues are addressed sincerely and genuinely...," the association said in its letter.

"We trust that you would take up our request at the earliest and invite us for an audience with you along with a few of our representatives," it said.

The committee of creditors of the grounded airline, led by State Bank of India, had

approved the resolution plan submitted by a consortium of UK's KLM Capital and UAE-based entrepreneur Muzari Lal Jalan in October 2020, to restart Jet Airways.

The airline has been grounded since April 2019 because of bankruptcy under its previous promoter Nansh Goyal.

The KLM-Jalan consortium has proposed to invest \$600 crore in the first two years in the grounded airline to repay creditors and acquire an 89.79% stake in the carrier.

It has also proposed to pay ₹51 crore, ₹93 crore, and ₹259 crore at the end of the third, fourth and fifth year, respectively, to financial creditors from the airline's cash flows.

Overall, the consortium hopes to repay ₹183 crore to creditors over five years, which would include collections from asset sale proceeds and cash flows.

# Jet staff ask govt to help solve issues

Non-payment of salary dues and job uncertainty top the list of concerns

An employees' group of Jet Airways (India) Ltd has sought the intervention of newly appointed civil aviation minister Jyotiraditya Scindia for resolving issues of employment under the new owners of the airline and clearance of social security dues that have accumulated under the previous management of the airline.

The All-India Jet Airways' Officers and Staff Association, which is affiliated to National Front of India Trade Unions, said in a letter addressed to Scindia on 27 July that it was shocked to see the paltry salary dues offered by the new owners of the airline, about ₹52 crore, which is a minuscule amount compared with the original claims of employees. "A large number of employees continue to be on the payroll of the company (Jet Airways) who have indicated complete uncertainty in respect of their

continued employment as they believe that they would contribute to the success of the revived entity of the successful resolution applicant," the letter said.

A copy of the letter has been reviewed by Mint.

"If the airline has to take off into the skies under a revived management, it is imperative that employee issues are addressed sincerely and genuinely....," the association said in its letter.

An employees' group of Jet Airways (India) Ltd has sought the intervention of newly appointed civil aviation minister Jyotiraditya Scindia for resolving issues of employment under the new owners of the airline and clearance of social security dues that have accumulated under the previous management of the airline.

The All-India Jet Airways' Officers and Staff Association, which is affiliated to National Front of India Trade Unions, said in a letter addressed to Scindia on 27 July that it was shocked to see the paltry salary dues offered by the new owners of the airline, about ₹52 crore, which is a minuscule amount compared with the original claims of employees. "A large number of employees continue to be on the payroll of the company (Jet Airways) who have indicated complete uncertainty in respect of their

continued employment as they believe that they would contribute to the success of the revived entity of the successful resolution applicant," the letter said.

A copy of the letter has been reviewed by Mint.

"If the airline has to take off into the skies under a revived management, it is imperative that employee issues are addressed sincerely and genuinely....," the association said in its letter.

"We trust that you would take up our request at the earliest and invite us for an audience with you along with a few of our representatives," it said.

approved the resolution plan submitted by a consortium of UK's Kalrock Capital and UAE-based entrepreneur Murari Lal Jalan in October 2020, to restart Jet Airways.

Investment-bound national carrier Air India Ltd has raised ₹738 crore from the sale of its real estate assets so far, while also realizing a rental income of about ₹100 crore annually from its properties, minister of state for civil aviation V.K. Singh told the Lok Sabha on Thursday.

Responding to a question from member of parliament Gurjeet Singh Aujla, Singh said Air India has sold 115 units of real estate assets between 2015 and 2021 (up to 12 July).

"Air India has identified 111 parcels of properties for monetization, out of which 106 parcels of properties are in India and the rest five are overseas properties," Singh said in his written response.

"The 111 parcels of properties consist of 211 units which are under monetization," he said.

Air India had earlier in July held an e-auction to sell several properties, including offices, flats and staff quarters at major metros such as New Delhi, Mumbai, Kolkata, Ahmedabad, Bengaluru, Mangaluru, Nashik and Nagpur. These properties include residential units at New Delhi's Asian Games Village Complex, flats at Bandra's Pali Hill neighbourhood, flats at Kolkata's Golfgreen locality and the airline's booking office at Nagpur, among others.

The e-auction, which closed

on 9 July, received a fair amount of interest from buyers and investors, considering the covid pandemic, a senior Air India official said, adding that the airline aims to raise about ₹200 crore to ₹300 crore from its asset monetization plan during the ongoing fiscal.

An employees' group of Jet Airways (India) Ltd has sought the intervention of newly appointed civil aviation minister Jyotiraditya Scindia for resolving issues of employment under the new owners of the airline and clearance of social security dues that have accumulated under the previous management of the airline.

The All-India Jet Airways' Officers and Staff Association, which is affiliated to National Front of India Trade Unions, said in a letter addressed to Scindia on 27 July that it was shocked to see the paltry salary dues offered by the new owners of the airline, about ₹52 crore, which is a minuscule amount compared with the original claims of employees. "A large number of employees continue to be on the payroll of the company (Jet Airways) who have indicated complete uncertainty in respect of their

continued employment as they believe that they would contribute to the success of the revived entity of the successful resolution applicant," the letter said.

A copy of the letter has been reviewed by Mint.

"If the airline has to take off into the skies under a revived management, it is imperative that employee issues are addressed sincerely and genuinely....," the association said in its letter.

"We trust that you would take up our request at the earliest and invite us for an audience with you along with a few of our representatives," it said.

The committee of creditors of the grounded airline, led by State Bank of India, had

approved the resolution plan submitted by a consortium of UK's Kalrock Capital and UAE-based entrepreneur Murari Lal Jalan in October 2020, to restart Jet Airways.

The airline has been grounded since April 2019 because of bankruptcy under its previous promoter Naresh Goyal.

The Kalrock-Jalan consortium has proposed to invest ₹600 crore in the first two

years in the grounded airline to repay creditors and acquire an 89.79% stake in the carrier.

It has also proposed to pay ₹131 crore, ₹193 crore, and ₹259 crore at the end of the

third, fourth and fifth year, respectively, to financial creditors from the airline's cash flows.

Overall, the consortium hopes to repay ₹1,183 crore to creditors over five years, which would include collections from asset sale proceeds and cash flows.

The Mumbai bench of the National Company Law Tribunal had in June approved the resolution plan submitted by the Kalrock Capital and Murari Lal Jalan consortium subject to further approvals, to restart Jet Airways.

Investment-bound national carrier Air India Ltd has raised ₹738 crore from the sale of its real estate assets so far, while also realizing a rental income of about ₹100 crore annually from its properties, minister of state for civil aviation V.K. Singh told the Lok Sabha on Thursday.

Responding to a question from member of parliament Gurjeet Singh Aujla, Singh said Air India has sold 115 units of real estate assets between 2015 and 2021 (up to 12 July).

"Air India has identified 111 parcels of properties for monetization, out of which 106 parcels of properties are in India and the rest five are overseas properties," Singh said in his written response.

"The 111 parcels of properties consist of 211 units which are under monetization," he said.

Air India had earlier in July held an e-auction to sell several properties, including offices, flats and staff quarters at major metros such as New Delhi, Mumbai, Kolkata, Ahmedabad, Bengaluru, Mangaluru, Nashik and Nagpur. These properties include residential units at New Delhi's Asian Games Village Complex, flats at Bandra's Pali Hill neighbourhood, flats at Kolkata's Golfgreen locality and the airline's booking office at Nagpur, among others.

The e-auction, which closed

on 9 July, received a fair amount of interest from buyers and investors, considering the covid pandemic, a senior Air India official said, adding that the airline aims to raise about ₹200 crore to ₹300 crore from its asset monetization plan during the ongoing fiscal.

The official requested anonymity.

It may be a challenge for Air India to raise a substantial amount of money from property sales as the real estate market hasn't yet recovered from the impact of the pandemic, said a senior aviation analyst with a foreign consultancy, who's been tracking the airline for sometime. "The sales during the pandemic will depend on the valuation put up by the airline and the location of these properties," the person added, requesting anonymity.

# Delhi Govt Set To Take Over Another School

## Sends Notice To Bal Bharati In Rohini After LG Nod

New Delhi: Delhi government has decided now to take over the management of another school having announced on Wednesday its intention to assume control of Apejay School in Sheikh Sarai. On Thursday, it sent a notice to Bal Bharati Public School in Rohini with the concurrence of lieutenant governor Anil Bajaj. The state government has taken this decision after the institution allegedly failed to comply with the directive to withdraw its "arbitrary" fee hike.

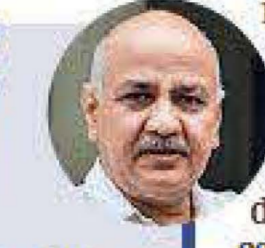
Deputy chief minister Manish Sisodia reiterated on Thursday that the Kejriwal government would not allow schools to increase fees in this manner. "If any school takes such steps, we will take strict action against them," said Sisodia.

According to the notice sent to Bal Bharati, "During the detailed inspection of the records, the Directorate of Education found that the total funds with the school for the year 2017-2018 were Rs

23,81,82,958. Out of this, Rs 20,94,38,802 was estimated to be spent ... the school management had a net surplus of about Rs 2,87,44,156. After this, the Directorate of Education concluded that there was no need for the school mana-

gement to increase the fees. In this regard, the Directorate refused to accept the fee hike proposed by the school for the academic session 2017-2018."

While the school had to adjust the hiked fees collected in 2017-18, the government received complaints from the parents that the school had increased the fees several times in

2018-19 and 2019-20, and also asked them to deposit the arrears. The order states, "Consequently, DoE issued a notice to the school on May 10, 2019, asking why the recognition of the school should not be cancelled or why the government should not take over the management of the school."

As the response of the school wasn't satisfactory, Delhi government has decided to initiate the process of taking over the management of the school.

The school reacted through a statement, saying, "We are yet to receive any communication from DoE and will consider the entire issue once we receive a direct communication. Bal Bharati Public School has always functioned within the provisions of DSEAR and followed all the judgements given by Hon'ble High Court of Delhi on related issues in the past and will continue to do so in the future also. We would like to assure parents of our students that we will always protect the interests of our students."

# Ggn carjacking: One of the boys threatened to slit driver's throat

When the driver resisted, the other boy placed a broken beer bottle on his neck and threatened to slit his throat if he did not stop the vehicle. Fearing for his life, the driver obliged. The two accused pushed him out near Hero Honda Chowk and drove away with the car. "Their drop-off location was Garhi Harsaru. A few minutes after getting into the car from Rajiv Chowk, one of them pointed a gun at me and asked me to stop. But I kept driving. The other one then placed a broken bottle at my neck and said he would attack me with it if I did not slam the brakes. They pushed me out of the car at Rajiv Chowk and fled with the vehicle. What could I have done?" Rafiq (30), the cabby, mentioned in his complaint.

A case was registered against both of them under sections 379B (snatching using force) and 34 (common intention) of the IPC. The police scanned CCTV clips and tracked them down in Sector 10 on Wednesday. The friendship of the two juveniles goes back a long way. While one of them is from Khandsa in Gurgaon and studies in Class XI of a private school in the city, the other one lives in Delhi and has appeared for his Class XII exams. Before going to stay with their parents, the two studied in the same junior school in Jhajjar and became friends there. Both would stay with their relatives then.

"One of them (the boy from Delhi) has a criminal record. When he was in Jhajjar, he had snatched a car and was sent to a juvenile home. This time, he involved his childhood friend to commit the crime and go for their dream vacation," said ACP (crime) Preet Pal Sangwan. Both the boys were produced before the juvenile justice board and were sent to a correction home in Faridabad.

# Pay homebuyers who are seeking refund, SC tells Supertech

The builder thereafter approached the apex court, which stayed the demolition of towers but directed the company to refund the amount to the buyer who wanted their money back.

Appearing before a bench of Justices D Y Chandrachud and M R Shah, advocate Ravindra Kumar for Noida authority said the authority had sanctioned the plan. He said the first approval was given in 2006 and subsequently the revised plan was approved in 2006, 2009 and 2012 by which the number of towers in the projects and the height of the tower was also allowed to be increased in different stages.

"There was nothing wrong on the part of the authority in sanctioning the plan and nothing was done that was against the law and approval was granted as per the rules," Kumar told the bench. He said the HC order was wrong and the authority separately filed an appeal against the order as many adverse observations were made by the HC against its officials.

Kumar said all 17 towers of the project are part of the same building cluster and all the towers can be adjacent to each other as per the law. "The distance between the tower is not in breach of bylaws. Ground area, green area or open area has not been taken over for construction of towers," he said.

The bench, however, said that such contention could not be accepted as there will be no open space between two towers.

Senior advocate Vikas Singh, appearing for Supertech, contended that three towers, which includes the two controversial towers, are part of one cluster with the same basement. He said Noida Building Regulation (NBR), 2010 could not be made applicable to the project which was sanctioned in 2009. He also emphasised that the distance between two towers should be six metres as per the new National Building Code and there was no violation of law by the builder.

Senior advocate Jayant Bhushan, appearing for Emerald Court Owner Resident Welfare Association, said that the approval and construction of the two towers was in complete violation of UP Apartment Acts and its approval was not taken before changing the plan for building new towers. The arguments remained inconclusive and would resume on August 3.

# FIR against app that 'auctioned' Muslim women, House told

New Delhi: In response to a question whether the issue of alleged open auction of Muslim women through online app "Sulli Deals" has come to the notice of the government, the Ministry of women and child development told the Rajya Sabha that as informed by the ministry of home affairs an FIR has been registered by the Delhi Police on July 7 against the alleged app. The WCD ministry has added that "police" and "public order" are state subjects and that the responsibility to maintain law and order rests primarily with the state governments, which are competent to deal with such offences under the law. IANS

# Panel to check Ghazipur mandi violations

New Delhi: National Green Tribunal on Thursday formed a joint committee of Central Pollution Control Board (CPCB), Delhi Pollution Control Committee (DPCC) and district magistrate (East), asking them to verify the ground situation at Ghazipur Murga Mandi and find out if any environmental damage was being caused by the local activities.

A bench headed by NGT chairperson Justice Adarsh

Kumar Goel said the joint committee needed to submit an action taken report within three months and asked DPCC to be the nodal agency for coordination and compliance.

"The joint committee may hold its first meeting within 15 days from today. It may visit the site, while other proceedings may be conducted online. The committee may take stock of the situation with reference to earlier reports also and ascertain updated remedial action in the matter," said the bench.

NGT, in a previous order on May 19, 2021, had directed the environment ministry to revise clearance for development of a "modern poultry and egg market" adjacent to the Ghazipur Mandi.

It also asked DPCC, in coordination with other agencies, to identify the violators and initiate prosecution to stop polluting activities and recover compensation for the past violations. IANS

# Pilot door-to-door vax drive to be held today

BMC to start drive in full swing from Aug 2; Patients need to keep docus ready

Starting Friday, the Brihanmumbai Municipal Corporation (BMC) will start administering Covid vaccines to bedridden patients at their door step.

According to civic official, the drive will be a pilot launch on Friday and will begin in full swing from August 2. On Friday, the BMC will cover K-east ward, which includes Andheri (E) and Jogeshwari areas. So far, the BMC has prepared a list of 4,488 bedridden patients, of which 209 registered beneficiaries are from the K-east ward. The officials said that patients will be administered Covaxin. BMC's executive health officer Mangala Gomare said that even though there are more than 200 bedridden patients registered in the ward, the actual number of people who will be inoculated on Friday may vary.

"Each patient will have to produce a doctor's certificate stating that they are fit to take the dose. Another certificate

"The drive on Friday will be a test for us as we will be able to analyse the problems we may face and work on them," she added. An NGO, Project Mumbai, has been roped in for the drive. They will provide logistical support like ambulances, nurses, doctors and volunteers, while the BMC will provide the vaccines. Gomare said that a nodal officer from the BMC will be present with the team

during the door-to-door visits. Meanwhile, CEO of Project Mumbai Shishir Joshi said that two teams of volunteers will be working simultaneously on Friday.

"We will start calling patients from morning. After getting a confirmation over the phone, our members will visit them at their residence and inoculate them after verifying the documents," Joshi told FPJ.

"We will be providing two ambulances, along with medical volunteers. The entire drive will be monitored by civic officials," he said.

## Three arrested by NCB for peddling drugs

The NCB, in two separate operations, arrested three persons, including a woman, allegedly involved in drug peddling. The agency has seized 183.4 grams of Mephedrone (MD) and cash Rs 18 lakh from the suspects. The agency sources said the cartel was being run from a posh Andheri hotel. Speaking about the operation, Zonal Director of Mumbai NCB, Sameer Wankhede said, on specific information, a team of NCB had raided Chawl at Amina Nagar, Idgah Maidan, Meghwadi in Jogeshwari East on Wednesday and intercepted one Abrar Khan and seized 80 grams of MD in his possession along with cash Rs 18 lakh from his house search. "Khan was supposed to deliver MD to someone near his residence in Jogeshwari. He is a history-sheeter and has criminal cases registered against him at Jogeshwari and Santacruz police stations in the years 2006 and 2009. He uses minor children for trafficking of drugs such as Ecstasy, Corex, Mephedrone, etc. in the Meghwadi area. We have registered a case against Khan and are probing further," Wankhede said. In another operation, on receipt of reliable information, the NCB team busted a drug cartel that was being run from a Three-Star Hotel at Andheri (E) and seized 103.4 grams of MD (commercial quantity) on Wednesday. - Staff Reporter

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## Andheri locals to fill up potholes themselves

Aggrieved with the pothole menace during every monsoon, residents and activists have called for a protest gathering on Friday during which they have decided to fill up the potholes at the Sahar Cargo Road, M C Chagla Road extension, Navpada Road and other places near Chhatrapati Shivaji Maharaj International Airport (CSMIA) on their own.

According to residents, pot-

holes near the airport are a constant affair. Former municipal corporator and trustee of Watchdog Foundation Nicholas Almeida said that there are more than 300 potholes along Cargo Road.

"Many trucks and tempos use this road frequently due to which the surface has been eroded. We have been writing about this to the BMC and other agencies for years, but in vain. I believe that the airport authority should take responsibility of its maintenance," Almeida said,

adding, at least 100 residents will visit the cargo road and will fill up the potholes on Friday.

"We have arranged for a tempo and all the raw material and logistics will be provided by us. After filling the potholes, we will plant a sapling in it," he added.

Another social activist Mushtaq Ansari said that he receives 15 to 20 complaints daily. "Out of the total complaints, four to five are from Andheri and most potholes are in the suburban belt,"

Ansari said. Meanwhile, assistant municipal commissioner and in-charge of K-east ward Prashant Sapkal said that the responsibility of maintaining Cargo Road and other areas is of the CSMIA and not BMC.

"This is a matter that happens every year, the area from where the complaints are raised is under the airport authority and we write to them every year, urging them to solve the problem at the earliest," Sapkal said.

# You may be able to walk in for second vax dose

The Brihanmumbai Municipal Corporation (BMC) has now decided to allow walk-ins to all those scheduled to receive their second vaccine dose in the first week of August. The civic body has requested the government of India (GOI) to grant them permission for the same.

Additional municipal commissioner Suresh Kakani said that considering there are more than 13 lakh beneficiaries on a waiting list for the second dose in August, of which five lakh will complete 84 days in the first week of August and need to be administered with Covid vaccine. Moreover, they are preparing guidelines for vaccinating a second dose at the Covid vaccine centres across the city.

"We have requested government to allow walk-ins to all beneficiaries above 18 years whose second dose is scheduled in August so that everyone gets their jobs on time. Moreover, our priority is to give the second doses for which we are preparing guidelines. Not all beneficiaries will complete 84 days on the same day. So we will ensure that everyone gets the doses," he said.

Kakani added that once they get a green signal from

GOI to start walk-in for beneficiaries with second doses then they will direct the respective wards to conduct vaccination drive in 60:40 ratio which means 60 per cent online registration for the first dose and 40 per cent walk for the second dose. "We have 1.80lakh doses which are adequate to vaccinate everyone and our main aim is to provide a second dose to the beneficiaries who will complete 84 days next month," concluded Kakani.

The vaccination drive for those above 18 years and above began on May 1 and after ten days it was halted as there were no vaccines. Initially, the gap between the two Covishield doses was four to six weeks, like Covaxin. It was then increased to six to eight weeks and yet again to 12 to 16 weeks on May 12.

While this helped prioritise the first doses, the civic body now faces the challenge of giving the second dose.

Since May, 33 lakh doses have been administered and only 11.6 lakh of these were second doses in Mumbai. Of these, 13.67 lakh people who received Covishield will complete 84 days next month. This includes five lakh people who will complete the maximum 112 days by August 31.

## Only 340 Covid cases reported

There was a slight drop in Covid cases across the city on Thursday, with 340 new infections and 13 deaths being reported in the last 24 hours. With this, the total count stands at 7,35,505, with 15,808 fatalities so far. Meanwhile, the doubling rate has increased to 1,407 days, while the weekly growth rate dropped to 0.05%.

The state also witnessed a jump in cases on Thursday, with 7,342 new infections and 190 fatalities being recorded in the last 24 hours, pushing the tally to 62,90,156, with 1,32,335 deaths so far. Moreover, the recovery rate touched to 96.59%, with 60,75,888 being discharged and recovered since the pandemic.

State surveillance officer Dr. Pradeep Awate said the weekly average rate of less than 5% itself indicates the waning of the second wave. "We ramped up medical infrastructure and also started mass vaccination, which played an important role in controlling the virus. However, some districts like Satara, Pune,

## Over 50,000 get the jab on Thursday

More than 50,000 beneficiaries were vaccinated in the city at the 414 covid vaccine centres. According to the data, 53,076 registered beneficiaries were inoculated, of which 42,653 had taken jab at private vaccine centres.

So far, 70.02 lakh beneficiaries have been vaccinated in the city since the pandemic outbreak, of which 53.25 lakh have taken the first dose, while 16.94 lakh have taken both the doses. Meanwhile, BMC stated that vaccination will be carried out at all government and municipal vaccination centres from 9 am to 5 pm on working days and information about the second day's vaccination will be provided through social media every evening at 5.30 pm.

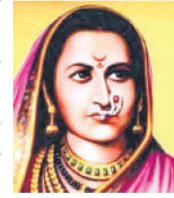

टर्मिनसचा (तत्कालीन व्हिक्टोरिया टर्मिनस) आराखडा तयार केलेल्या वास्तुविशारद फ्रेड्रिक विल्यम स्टीवन्स यांनी इमारतीचे आराखडे तयार केले होते. गॉथिक पद्धतीने उभारण्यात आलेल्या इमारतीने मुंबईतील आतापर्यंतचे बदल टिपले आहेत. १८५३मध्ये मध्य रेल्वेवर सुरु झालेली बोरीबंदर-ठाणे आणि त्यापाठोपाठ १८६७ मध्ये चर्चगेट-विवार लोकल सुरु झाली. त्यानंतर मुंबई पालिका मुख्यालय इमारत उभारण्यात आली आहे. मुंबईकरांसाठी प्रवास आणि प्रशासकीय दृष्टीने ही जागा महत्त्वाची ठरली. या इमारतीचे बांधकाम २५ एप्रिल १८८९ मध्ये सुरु झाले आणि २९ जुलै १८९३ रोजी ते पूर्णत्वास गेले. ऐतिहासिक

महत्त्व लाभलेल्या इमारतीस ३१ जुलै रोजी १२८ वर्षे पूर्ण होत आहेत. त्याचे औचित्य साधत वीरमाता जिजाऊ स्मृती मंडळाचे अध्यक्ष महादेव (भाऊ) सावंत यांनी महापौर किशोरी पेडणेकर यांना प्रत्यक्ष भेटून निवेदन सादर केले आहे. त्यात मुख्यालयातील सभागृहास अद्याप महानगरपालिका सभागृह म्हणून संबोधिले जाते. त्यामुळे, या सभागृहास 'राजमाता जिजाऊ सभागृह' असे नाव देण्यात यावे, अशी सूचना केली आहे.

## अखेर घाटकोपर मानखुर्द उड्डाणपुलाला छत्रपती शिवाजी महाराज यांचेच नाव

घाटकोपर मानखुर्द उड्डाणपुलाच्या नामकरणच्या वादावर अखेर पडदा पडला आहे. आज झालेल्या स्थापत्य समितीच्या बैठकीत घाटकोपर-मानखुर्दला जोडणाऱ्या नव्या पुलाला अखेर 'छत्रपती शिवाजी महाराज उड्डाणपूल' असे नाव देण्यावर शिक्कामोर्तब झाल्याचे स्थापत्य समिती अध्यक्ष (उपनगरे) स्वप्नील टेंबवलकर यांनी सांगितले. दरम्यान, पालिकेच्या एम पूर्व विभागातील वीर जिजांमता भोसले मार्गावर हा उड्डाणपूल बांधण्यात आला आहे.

उड्डाणपुलाचे बांधकाम २५ जुलैपर्यंत पूर्ण करण्याचे आश्वासन प्रशासनाकडून देण्यात आले होते. दरम्यान या पुलाचे बांधकाम पूर्ण झाल्याचे प्रमुख अभियंता (पूल) सतीश ठोसर यांनी लेखी कळवले आहे. यानुसार उड्डाणपुलाला 'छत्रपती शिवाजी महाराज उड्डाणपूल' नाव देण्याचा प्रस्ताव मंजूर करण्यात आला आहे.

या पुलाला शिवरायांचे नाव देण्याची मागणी डिसेंबर २०२० मध्ये शिवसेनेकडून सर्वप्रथम नगरसेविका वैशाली शेवाळे यांच्याकडून पत्राद्वारे करण्यात आली होती. मात्र भाजपने अलीकडेच पुलाला शिवरायांचे नाव देण्याची मागणी पुन्हा एकदा केली. दरम्यान, 'सपा'चे गटनेते रईस शेख यांनी 'सुलतानुल हिंद ख्वाजा गरीब नवाझ' यांचे नाव देण्याची मागणी केल्याने वाद निर्माण होण्याची शक्यता निर्माण झाली होती. मात्र शिवसेना नगरसेविका निधी शिंदे यांनी आजच्या बैठकीत मांडलेली उपसूचना बहुमताने मंजूर करून पुलाला 'छत्रपती शिवाजी महाराज उड्डाणपूल' असे नाव देण्यात आले.

### मुंबईबाहेर जाताना वेळेची बचत !

घाटकोपर-मानखुर्दला जोडणारा हा उड्डाणपूल शिवाजी नगर ते मोहिते पाटील जंक्शनपर्यंत २.९० किमी तयार करण्यात आला आहे. या उड्डाण पुलामुळे विभागातील शिवाजीनगर जंक्शन, बैगनवाडी जंक्शन, देवनार डंपिंग ग्राउंड, फायर ब्रिगेड व मोहिते पाटील येथील वाहतूक कोंडीतूनही मुक्तता होणार आहे. पालिकेने प्रथमच २४.२ मीटर सेगमेंट कास्टिंग तयार करून या पुलाचे बांधकाम केले आहे. या पुलामुळे नवी मुंबई, पनवेल, पुण्याला जाणाऱ्या प्रवाशांची २५ मिनिटे वाचणार आहेत.

मुंबई प्रदूषण मुक्त करण्यासाठी मुंबई महापालिकेने प्रदूषण वाढीचा अभ्यास करण्याचा निर्णय घेतला आहे. यासाठी ५ ठिकाणी प्रदूषण मापक यंत्र बसवण्यात येणार असून यंत्राच्या माध्यमातून अभ्यास करत प्रदूषण रोखण्यासाठी उपाययोजना करणार असल्याचे पर्यावरण विभागाचे उप आयुक्त सुनील गोडसे यांनी सांगितले.

पर्यावरणाचा समतोल राखण्यासाठी प्रदूषणावर नियंत्रण मिळवणे गरजेचे आहे. गेल्या वर्षी मार्च महिन्यात मुंबईत कोरोनाचा शिरकाव त्यानंतर मुंबईतील प्रदूषणात घट झाली होती. परंतु लॉकडाऊनचे नियम शिथिल होताच पुन्हा प्रदूषणात वाढ झाल्याचे निष्कर्ष आवाज फाउंडेशनच्या अहवालातून समोर आले होते. परंतु आता मुंबई प्रदूषण मुक्त करण्यासाठी पालिका प्रशासनाने अभ्यास करण्याचा निर्णय घेतला

असून यासाठी पंतनगर महानगर पालिका शाळा, घाटकोपर पूर्व, शिवाजी नगर बेस्ट डेपा, देवनार, माहलगाव महानगर पालिका, वीरमाता जिजाबाई भोसले उद्यान भायखळा व चारकोप प्रसुतिगृह या ५ ठिकाणी नवे प्रदूषण मापक यंत्र बसवण्याचा निर्णय घेतला आहे. केंद्र सरकारच्या सिस्टीम ऑफ एअर क्वालिटी अँड वेदर फॉरकास्टिंग अँड रिसर्च (सफर) उपक्रमांतर्गत आठ ठिकाणी स्वयंचलित प्रदूषण मापके बसविण्यात आली आहेत. या प्रदूषण मापकांमार्फत या ठिकाणाच्या प्रदूषणाची नोंदणी मोबाईल ॲप्लिकेशनवरही उपलब्ध होते. मुंबई महानगर पालिका ५५ ठिकाणी अशीच प्रदूषण मापके बसवणार आहे. पहिल्या टप्प्यात त्यातील पाच ठिकाणे निश्चित झाले आहेत. या पाच ठिकाणी प्रदूषण मापके बसविण्याचा प्रशासकीय प्रस्ताव तयार करण्यात आला आहे, असे गोडसे यांनी सांगितले.
